Residents and guests attended the meeting by videoconference.

At 6 p.m., the Town Council met with residents of Thornapple Street to discuss the prospective sale and future development of the 4-H property.

At 7 p.m., the Town Council held a work session to discuss the Planning Department's recommendations related to "Attainable Housing Strategies;" opting-in to the County's Healthy Lawns Act; and the status of the Racial Justice Special Committee. The Council asked the Town's Climate and Environment Committee to provide more research and empirical data related to the success of the Healthy Lawns Act in other communities that have adopted the law. The Council asked the Racial Justice Special Committee to provide additional information related to its request to be established as a standing committee.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.

At 8:30 p.m., the Council met in open session for the purpose of voting to enter a closed session.
